

## PLASTER CARE

In order to validate the warranty of your plaster, it is important to follow these instructions for care.

Upon plaster the plaster company will put your hose in the pool to start filling up. *It is your responsibility to do the following:*

After the pool is full, (mid tile line), place hose in spa to fill. Keep towel around hose.

After start-up, brush pool and spa 4 times a day for 4 days. First 24 hours is most critical. After that, 2-3 times a day for 2 weeks is sufficient. This ensures a smooth surface.

The "cloudiness" in the water is not plaster dust but calcium carbonate that has precipitated out of the water upon filling. Do not swim until water is clear, usually about 4 days. We recommend cleaning your filter after about 2 weeks initially. After that when your filter pressure gauge reads about 7 p.s.i. higher than normal, it is time to clean again.

Do not heat spa for 5 days while plaster is curing.

Keep hair lint basket in your pump clean in order to avoid pump from overheating. A basket full of debris will weaken the ability of your system to function at full potential. The same applies to your skimmer(s) basket(s).

*For colored plaster or pebble plaster refer to the fact sheet provided by the plaster company. Most plaster problems are not the plaster at all but improper care and maintenance.*
